#### 33 GWYNEDD & ANGLESEY JOINT PLANNING POLICY UNIT.

The Draft Supplementary Planning Guidance consultation document was received from the Gwynedd & Anglesey Joint Planning Policy Unit. These concentrated on "Tourism Facilities and Accommodation" and "Housing Mix". The Documents were received at the end of May and responses were required by the 5 July at the latest.

RESOLVED – as the documentation was bulky and one of them "Tourism Facilities and Accommodation" of significance within the Community Council area to seek an extension to the end of July for responses.

# 34 TREH & CO – LEASE OF CAER BERLLAN PLAYGROUND.

Letters were received from the Community Councils' solicitors seeking confirmation and official minutes regarding the following in the preparation of the new Lease for Caer Berllan Playground:-

- 1. The Isle of Anglesey County Council relate to the Caer Berllan site as "land adjacent to Hafod, Amlwch Road, Benllech". Further, when the land was purchased by the Gwynedd County Council in 1972 it was regarded as the site for the new Benllech Library. However, matters did not proceed and the County Council believe this is how the anomaly arose. The Isle of Anglesey County Council have applied to the Land Registry to correct the description.
- 2. Confirmation is sought that none of the covenants in the first, second or both conveyances pose a problem for the Community Council. The first conveyance relates to the building line and the second conveyance relates to making available any increase in the parking facility to the members of the Benllech Methodist Chapel.

**RESOLVED** – agreement to proceed with the required changes for the new Lease.

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# 35 TRAFFIC SITUATION IN BENLLECH SQUARE.

A welcome was extended to the Tesco store manager to the meeting to further discuss the complex traffic flow situation in Benllech Square. Many examples were given of queues and minor accidents happening. The Tesco representative explained that the company's Regional Risk Manager was attending shortly and invited the Chair and County Councillor to the site meeting.

No response had been forthcoming to the letter sent to the Head of Highways at the Isle of Anglesey County Council following the May Meeting and it was decided to send a further letter to Highways mentioning the proposed meeting at Tesco and inviting them to send a representative thereto.
