The Chair extended a welcome to the meeting to Enid Williams deputising on behalf of Dafydd Humphreys and Geraint Stello, Guest Speaker from the Red Squirrel Trust.

**1. Introduction Geraint Strello Guest**

The background of the Trust's program on the island was given, although it started over 30 years ago in Malltraeth Forest with Esme Kirby as one of the founders. Red squirrels are now around 800 in number, and it is estimated that they are worth around a million pounds in tourism income. The risk continues from the grey squirrel and the disease it carries. Geraint was in discussions with Dafydd Humphreys about ways to increase the use of the public paths in the area and if using the presence of the squirrels would help to promote them Geraint would be happy to help. It was suggested to install cameras in specific places to see them. Standard cameras cost between £60 and £100. They could be of interest to locals and visitors alike. He suggested discussing with Natural Resources Wales or discussing with the IoACC Wildlife Officer - Aurora Hood about the possibility of getting grants for this.

Cllr GR – suggest some routes near the Surgery that might be suitable. It could be combined with the Green Medicine scheme which is currently being promoted for well-being.

GS – important not to attract them to areas where there is a high level of traffic and create a risk for them.

Cllr RhM - important to develop Y Libart, and could be combined with replanting tree species to replace the disappearing ash trees.

GR - squirrels are regularly seen in Coed y Glyn

GS - important to plant trees where there are gaps in banks.

Cllr IW – Marianglas area through to Llanfair ME is also a good area to see.

Cllr KG – people or feeding in the Craig y Don area.

Cllr JH – inquires if it is possible to get additional signs to designate a red squirrel area.

GS- the discussion ended with an offer from GS to return again if he could be of help.

**2. Public Participation**

No one present.

**3. Receive Council Meeting Minutes 22.5.23**

- Remembrance Day - gone in order
- AONB and Tourism Consultation - response sent on behalf of the Council.

It was proposed to accept the Minutes correctly by Councillor KG, seconded by Cllr JH.

**4. Council Calendar** - it was noted that there will be no meeting in July and August because it is difficult to get a quorum. Also the clerk will be on holiday during this period, as he has a lot of holiday due to him. No meeting in December.

It was proposed to accept the Calendar by Cllr GR and seconded by Cllr JH.

**5. Actions** – everything in green completed, blue – member action; yellow – Work in progress

- Marian Signs - need more dog poo signs. A sign in the square about the toilets.
- Benches - prices obtained for £300 for restoration. Allow the Clerk to prioritise where renovation was most needed. Cllr GR proposed to buy composite benches. Cllr WO suggested getting prices from another supplier but the Chair pointed out that it was difficult to get anyone ready to undertake the work.
- Cllr IW offered to renew 5 for £1,500 and get the price of some composites for additional ones, and the offer was accepted. Need to ensure they are of recycled use.
- Additional bins over the summer - the Chair reported that it was a difficult task to get extra bins during the summer. Cllr IW proposed to plead the case, again, with the department at IoACC. It was suggested that the Council pay for the extras and get BIFA to empty them. Additional bins are given in Beaumaris because the Pier is the property of the Council.
- Visit to Partneriaeth Ogwen. – great visit. They had been able to secure additional funding to start and establish the Partnership but developed with great ideas. Need to look at simulating some of the ideas in this area when income from the tender review of the toilets and the car park have been completed. Idea - create a Community Garden or Memorial Garden. The back of SPAR was suggested as a possible location. A word of warning from Cllr IW - constant maintenance work is required, but he would ask Dylan Edwards about the ownership of this land. Cllr KG suggested that there was more potential in the land near Craig y Don.
- Co-op Grant – no further information.
- Cyngh RhM a JH – look again at grants in connection with the red squirrel.
- Clerk's Appraisal - Cllr WO suggested that Un Llais Cymru would have a template. Cllr IW noted that there has been a tremendous improvement since the appointment of DH and shouldn't that be sufficient? Cllr WO noted that there is value in the process to ensure continuous improvement and Cllr JH confirmed that an appraisal/ evaluation is a two-way process giving the Clerk the opportunity to voice any dissatisfaction or concerns, and therefore good practice. It was agreed that the Finance Committee/ Human Resources Panel should undertake the setting of criteria and include it as an annual.

This action was proposed by Cllr IW and seconded by Cllr KG.

**6. Correspondence**

**6.1** Request from Janet Peerce for signs on Lôn Gwenfro. It was agreed that the Community Council make a request to the County Council for signs. The Clerk was asked to acknowledge the letter and send it to the County Council.

**6.2** 20mph speed limits. It was discussed that additional areas were needed

- Lôn y Traeth / Beach Road
- Siop Ty'n Gongl/ Llys Paradwys, Minffordd towards Llanfair M E and Marian-glas.

- Llanbedrgoch - from Bryn Eurad to the corner of the church, and from the square to the school

Traffic Regulation - extending 'no parking' to Craig y Don and the 'Beds & Stuff' shop  
Cllr IW noted that one person had to put out a 'cone' to be able to get her car from the garage near Tyddyn Fadog

Cllr GR reported that the public did not always understand that the location of yellow lines was determined for safety reasons and not to generate additional income for the car parks.

Cllr WO inquired about signs at the beach.

**6.3** Traffic situation in the square - It was understood that IoACC is expecting the result of a grant application to the Welsh Government (encouraging walking and cycling) but there will not be an answer until 2024. Cllr IW noted that something is imminently, and that was the main topic of concern at a recent meeting of the Older People's Forum.

It was agreed to invite Dylan Williams and/or Huw Percy once again to be present at the next meeting of the Council, through a letter from the Clerk stating the strength of the Council's feeling about this.

The Chairman noted that it would be necessary to ensure the presence of ALL Councilors if they agreed to accept the invitation. Also to enquire if they have a short term plan for the Summer.

It was proposed to have a local contractor come to JH, DH and RhoO to look at how the old system could be made to work or put a drain around it.

The Chair expressed concern that we will have missed good weather to do the Work, and that it will not be possible to complete it during the winter. It was suggested to action the drain now, and re-examine the soakaway again, maybe in a year's time.

Cllr IW proposed that the necessary Work be done in August/September Following advice from KR, DH, JH and RhoO, seconded by Councilors GR and WO.
