Cadw Beddau'n Daclus

Mae'r Cyngor Cymuned wedi ymrwymo i gynnal y fynwent fel amgylchedd diogel, parchus a thaclus i bob ymwelydd. Caiff y glaswellt ei dorri'n rheolaidd a chynhelir archwiliad gweledol wythnosol.

Cyfrifoldeb y teuluoedd yw cadw'r beddau a'r ardal gyfagos uniongyrchol yn daclus ac yn rhydd o eitemau a allai ddod yn anniogel neu achosi anawsterau cynnal a chadw. Ni ddylid rhwystro'r ardaloedd glaswelltog, gan arwain at yr angen i symud eitemau er mwyn cynnal a chadw'r fynwent.

Addurniadau Ychwanegol

Ni chaniateir gosod addurniadau ychwanegol ar feddau heb ganiatâd ymlaen llaw gan y Cyngor Cymuned. Gall fod ffi yn daladwy ar gyfer nodweddion parhaol.

Lle cymeradwyir addurniadau ychwanegol:

- Rhaid i eitemau fod yn addas ac yn barchus i amgylchedd y fynwent
- Bydd eitemau'n cael eu harchwilio o ran diogelwch a phriodoldeb
- Rhaid i addurniadau gael eu gosod neu eu sicrhau'n gadarn er mwyn atal symudiad neu ddifrod

Rhaid i deuluoedd gytuno i gynnal unrhyw addurniadau a gymeradwyir a sicrhau eu bod yn parhau'n ddiogel ac mewn cyflwr da. Mae'r Cyngor yn cadw'r hawl i symud unrhyw eitemau sy'n anniogel, wedi'u difrodi, heb awdurdod neu'n amhriodol.

Rhesymau dros Gyfyngu ar Addurniadau

Mae rheoli addurniadau yn angenrheidiol er mwyn sicrhau:

- Mynediad diogel i ymwelwyr a staff cynnal a chadw
- Gweithrediad diogel offer cynnal a chadw
- Atal peryglon baglu ac eitemau rhydd
- Cadw golwg barchus a chyson yr amgylchedd
- Er mwyn atal eitemau rhag dod yn rhydd neu ddirywio, gan arwain at sbwriel yn yr amgylchedd.

Cemetery Grave Maintenance and Decoration Policy

Keeping Graves Tidy

The Community Council is committed to maintaining the cemetery as a safe, respectful and well-kept environment for all visitors. The grass is cut regularly and a weekly, visual check is undertaken.

Families are responsible for keeping graves and immediate surrounding areas tidy and free from items that may become unsafe or create maintenance difficulties. The grass areas should not be obstructed causing the grass-cutters to have to move any items themselves in order to maintain the cemetery.

Additional Decorations

No additional decorations may be placed on graves without prior consent from the Community Council. There may be a fee to pay for permanent features.

Where additional decorations are approved:

- Items must be suitable and respectful to the cemetery environment
- Items will be inspected for safety and appropriateness
- Decorations must be securely fixed or placed to prevent movement or damage

Families must agree to maintain any approved decorations and ensure they remain safe and in good condition. The Council reserves the right to remove items that become unsafe, damaged, unauthorised or inappropriate.

Reasons for Limiting Decorations

- Decoration controls are necessary to ensure:
- Safe access for visitors and maintenance staff
- Safe operation of maintenance equipment
- Prevention of trip hazards and loose items
- Preservation of the respectful and consistent appearance of the cemetery environment
- Becoming loose or deteriorating, resulting in litter within the environment.
